I went stationary at Canal Park and Ptl. Fyffe went stationary at the AECU.</p>
	<p>At 8:04 P. M., Ptl. Fyffe advised he was behind the vehicle and ran the tag number, WV, 4KB131 and it came back to Enterprise Rent-A-Car. At 8:05 P. M., he advised he was out with that vehicle at Speedway. At 8:06 P. M., I also advised the dispatcher that I was out with Ptl. Fyffe to assist him. At 8:07 P. M., Ptl. Fyffe checked the DS of</p>

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two subjects. The first DS was 405256836 and came back to David Burton and the second DS 282787547, came back to Heather Hren, who was suspended. I then read Ms. Hren her constitutional rights and had Ptl. Fyffe hand cuff her and put Ms. Hren in the back of his cruiser.

After she was put in the cruiser, I had the passenger David Burton get out of the vehicle, so that we could do an inventory of the vehicle prior to having it towed. Trp. Crabtree and Sgt John Howard of the OSP stopped to assist on the stop. Trp. Crabtree helped with the inventory and he located a purse in the front part of the compartment of the vehicle. I observed him checking the purse and he pulled out a clear plastic baggie that was in the purse. He also pulled out a wallet that had Ms. Hren's SSN card. Trp. Crabtree then took the green pills that were in the baggie and I watched him count them. He counted 86 of the green pills and he then put them back in the baggie and gave them to me. I then had Ptl. Fyffe get an evidence bag and we put the pills in the evidence bag. The bag was then put in the front seat of his cruiser.

At that time, I placed the passenger, David Burton, in hand cuffs and also read his constitutional rights to him. He was then placed in the back of my cruiser. We found Mr. Burton's wallet in the front compartment and it was also put in an evidence bag and put in Ptl. Fyffe's cruiser. We then finished the inventory. during the inventory, I found a Enterprise renter agreement that the vehicle was rented to Mike Mearan. I then had the vehicle towed by Heistad's.

At 8:47 P. M., Ptl. Fyffe marked he was enroute to the station with one female prisoner and at 8:48 P. M., I also marked that I was enroute to the station with one male prisoner.

At the police station, I called Det. Evans and explained to him we had two subjects who needed to be interviewed and asked him to come in and assist.

At 9:55 P. M., Det. Evans and I read the Waverly Police Department Constitutional Rights form to David Perry Burton. He then read the waiver back to us and signed the waiver and agreed to speak with us. Mr. Burton advised that he went to his Oak Hill Bank and withdrew \$4,100.00 because he had found a deal on some OxyContin 80's for \$45.00 each. He then said that his girlfriend, Heather Hren, knew a man up around Columbus that he could trust with his money and would get the pills for him. Ms. Hren then drove him to Columbus. He advised they used the vehicle her boss Mike Mearan had rented.

He advised that they met someone by the name Roger ,or some thing, at a park and gave him the money. He left for about 20 minutes and returned with the pills. David advised that he took one of the pills and gave Roger one. He said that he then gave them to his girl friend and she put their pills in her purse. Mr. Burton went on to tell us how he uses the pills to get high and that he does not sell them. He also told us that the same pill would go for \$80.00 each in Portsmouth.

At 11:54 P. M., Det. Evans and I read the Waverly Police Department Constitutional Rights form to Heather Leigh Hren and she then said that she wanted an attorney. At that time the interview was stopped.

Det. Evans then typed up the charges. They were both charged with Aggravated Possession of Drug---2925.11 (A)(C)(1) of the Ohio Revised Code, an F-2. They were both then finger printed and had their picture taken and copies of the charges were given to them and they were then transported to Ross County Jail and booked.

At 9:30 P. M., I logged the pills in as evidence on shelf C-3.
