

ORDINANCE

To submit to the electors of the City of Portsmouth, Ohio, at the Primary Election to be held on the 2nd day of May, 2006 proposed amendments to Section 6 of the Charter of the City of Portsmouth, Ohio.

Whereas, Section 166 of the Charter of the City of Portsmouth, Ohio, and Article XVIII, Section 9 of the Constitution of the State of Ohio, authorize this Council to submit to the electors of the City of Portsmouth, Ohio, proposed amendments to the City Charter; and

Whereas, the City Council has determined that the questions of the adoption of the proposed amendment to the Charter of the City of Portsmouth should be submitted to the electors of the City of Portsmouth, Ohio, at the Primary Election to be held on the 2nd day of May, 2006, and that they should be submitted as hereinafter provided; and

Whereas, it is necessary in order that said proposed Charter amendments be placed on the ballot in the Primary Election to be held on the 2nd day of May, 2006, that this ordinance be passed and become effective at least sixty (60) days prior to said Primary Election. Now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Portsmouth, Ohio:

SECTION I. That there be submitted to the electors of the City of Portsmouth, Ohio, at the Primary Election to be held on the 2nd day of May, 2006, a proposed amendment to existing Charter Section 6, the amended portions of said section contained in said proposed amendments to read as follows:

SECTION 6. THE SALARY OF COUNCIL MEMBERS AND PRESIDENT OF COUNCIL.

The Council shall determine its salary, and that of the President of council, which salaries shall be payable in equal month installments, and shall give bond in the sum of one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00), with some bonding company regularly accredited to do business in the State of Ohio, or at least two freeholders resident of Scioto County, Ohio as sureties thereof, and the premium of such bond may be paid by the City. The bonds of the members of Council shall be filed with the City Auditor.

The foregoing proposed amendment, if approved by the electors of the City of Portsmouth, shall become effective and become a part of the Charter of said City upon passage, and

the corresponding existing section or sections shall thereby be repealed.

SECTION II. That the question of the adoption of the proposed amendment to the Charter of the City of Portsmouth, Ohio, be submitted to the voters of said City at the Primary Election to be held on the 2nd day of May, 2006, at the regular voting places within the City of Portsmouth, Ohio, between the hours prescribed by law.

SECTION III. That the ballot used for the voting on said proposed charter amendment shall have printed across the top thereof and below the stub the words "OFFICIAL QUESTIONS AND ISSUES BALLOT."

The printed matter pertaining to this issue on the ballot shall be enclosed at the top and bottom thereof by a heavy horizontal line across the width of the ballot. Immediately below such top line shall be printed the words "Proposed Charter Amendment" followed by the words "A majority vote is necessary for passage."

Immediately below such brief title and statement of the percentage of affirmative votes required for passage, shall be printed a condensed text of the proposed amendment submitted by that particular issue. The condensed text to be printed upon the ballots for the issue as descriptive of the contents of the proposed amendment included in said issue, shall be as follows:

Shall the Charter of the City of Portsmouth, Ohio be amended as follows:

- No. 1 Shall the Charter of the City of Portsmouth, Ohio, be amended to amend Section 6 to strike the words "...Each member of the Council shall receive a salary of six hundred dollars (\$600.00) a year, provided that the member selected to serves as President of council shall receive a salary of one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00) per year, ..., to the approval of the Sinking Fund Commission, ...Sinking Fund Commission and by it recorded in a book provided for such purpose."

Immediately below the ballot title, or printed condensed text of the issue, shall appear the following propositions, one above the other, in the order indicated:

FOR THE CHARTER AMENDMENT : :

AGAINST THE CHARTER AMENDMENT : :

Adjacent to each proposition there shall be a method by which

the elector may vote for or against the Charter amendment as provided on the Computer Election System.

SECTION IV. That the City Clerk be and she hereby is directed to advertise for two (2) consecutive weeks in a newspaper of general circulation within the City of Portsmouth, Ohio, to advise each elector of said city that a proposed amendment to the Charter of the City of Portsmouth will be submitted at an election for their approval or rejection.

SECTION V. That the City Clerk be and she hereby is directed to forthwith certify a copy of this ordinance to the Board of Elections of Scioto County, Ohio.

SECTION VI. The City Auditor is herein authorized and directed to draw his warrants on the Contingent Fund to cover the costs of advertising of said proposed charter amendment.

SECTION VII. The City Clerk of the City of Portsmouth, Ohio, is hereby authorized and directed to publish the within ordinance by posting a true and authenticated copy thereof on the bulletin board in the lobby of the second floor of the Municipal Building located at 728 Second Street in the City of Portsmouth, for a period of not less than fifteen (15) days.
