RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING FILING OF APPLICATION WITH THE ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT ADMINISTRATION, U. S. DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE, UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, FOR A GRANT AND/OR LOAN UNDER THE TERMS OF PUBLIC LAW 89-136.

Whereas, under the terms of Public Law 89-136, the United States of America has authorized the making of grants and/or loans to public bodies and private or public nonprofit organizations or associations to aid in financing the construction of specific public projects. Now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Portsmouth, Ohio:

SECTION I. That the City Manager of the City of Portsmouth, Ohio, be and he is hereby authorized to execute and file an application on behalf of the City of Portsmouth, Ohio, with the Economic Development Administration, U. S. Department of Commerce, for a grant and/or loan to aid in financing the construction of expansion of Portsmouth Water Works treatment capacity from eight million gallons to sixteen million gallons of water per day to meet industrial and residential growth needs of the Portsmouth area; and the construction of a new twelve (12") inch water line along industrial growth area of U. S. Route 23 north of Portsmouth to unincorporated village of Lucasville with a 500,000 gallon steel water storage tank.

SECTION II. That Franklin T. Gerlach, City Manager of the City of Portsmouth, Ohio, be and he is hereby authorized and directed to furnish such information as the Economic Development Administration, U. S. Department of Commerce, may reasonably request in connection with the application which is herein authorized to be filed.

SECTION III. This Resolution shall be in force and effect from and after its adoption.
